We try to arrange the rota so you get to dance with as many other sides as possible. Please arrange amongst yourselves the order of dancing at each spot. Chapel Morris will manage the collecting bucket on the day so you can all concentrate on dancing. The massed finale at The Slopes, with photo at the end, will enable you to catch any sides you've missed.

We have split lunch times (8 teams for each slot) so the dancing continues through the day. We've allocated 1hr 15 mins for lunch and for you to get to your after-lunch spot.
