1	It's beginning to be clear what they share with Buxton Opera.	
2	Their bells make a pleasant sound, a sort of tonal "ding".	
3	In 1877 Buxton FC was founded. 18, 7, 7 . Hmm, wonder what those letters are?	
4	A Fifty Three might get you to keel over <b>Hint: Roundabout</b>	
5	Where to park the Landau on the Market Place? It's a matter of taste. <b>Hint: Market Place</b>	
6	Above the 'old pumphouse', in letters of gold, 3,4,6,9,8 plus Buxton's river so I'm told <b>Hint: The Crescent</b>	
7	Just listen, won't you. Why, why, why, why, why?	
8	Confused? Scream, then you'll find this team	
9	Dashing between the little church and the trees.	
10	First three letters of this side add up to twice the Crescent arches <b>Hint: The Crescent</b>	
11	It's big enough not to need your support (or anyone else's) for a whole 24 hours <b>Hint: Uni</b>	
12	Would you find paradise in this pub? The first three letters will give you a clue to these dancers <b>Hint: Spring Gardens</b>	
13	When it goes out next to the Taj Mahal you might see this. <b>Hint: Higher Buxton</b>	
14	The way to 'stage an entrance' has an environmental following. <b>Hint: Opera House</b>	
15	Two are set up high on a crescent but you only need one, chased by a mount <b>Hint: The Crescent</b>
