Dance spots

All dance spots are c45 minutes long and are within easy walking distance (except for the hill to and from the Market Place) and there will be 4 sides at each spot. There is a 15 min changeover time to enable you to get to your next spot. Please arrange amongst yourselves the order of dancing at each spot. Chapel Morris will manage the collecting on the day so you can all concentrate on dancing. Collection goes towards a charity decided at our AGM. We try to arrange the rota so you get to dance with as many other sides as possible and the Grand Finale at The Slopes will enable you to catch any sides you've missed. Grand Finale will be a show dance by each side ending with massed Bonny Green.

Lunch

We've split lunch so the dancing continues through the day. You have c1hr 15 mins for lunch and to get to your after-lunch spot. There are many food options in Buxton from pub lunches, takeaways, sandwich shops, cafes and open spaces for picnics etc but please 'spread yourselves out' as not all establishments are geared up for a sudden large influx.
